


Narrator: This is a story about a farmer and a very, very big carrot.

Narrator: The farmer wants to eat


the carrot.

Cow: Yes, of course.




Narrator: The farmer pulls the carrot.

All: Pull... pull... pull...


Narrator: The farmer, the cow and the horse pull and pull but the carrot doesn't move.

Farmer: Can you help me, please?


Sheep: Yes, of course.



Narrator: The farmer pulls the carrot. The cow pulls the farmer. The horse pulls the cow. The sheep pulls the horse.


All: Pull... pull... pull...


All: Pull... pull... pull...


